Significance of Surat al-Fatiha

'Ubadah bin As-Swamit reported that the Messenger of Allah said: There is no prayer for one who has not read the Opening of the Book.

(Mishkat Al-Masabih with reference to Bukhari and Muslim).

Abu Hurayrah reported that the Messenger of Allah said thrice: Whoso prays without reading therein the Mother of the Qur'an, it is defective (three times he repeated) and incomplete. It was said to Abu Hurayrah: We remain behind the Imam. He said: Read it within yourself, because I heard the Messenger of Allah.... (Hadith is long and goes into the merits of the Surah).

'Ubadah bin As-Swamit narrated: We were behind the Messenger of Allah in the Salat Al-Fajr, he recited that became heavy for us. After finishing the prayer he said: Perhaps you recite behind your Imam; we said: Yes O Messenger of Allah. He said: Do not do it except Al-Fatiha.
